

Hindenburg Keyboard Shortcuts

Spacebar	Play/Stop	The Spacebar is used to start and stop playback
Cmd/Ctrl + plus/minus or Cmd/Ctrl + mouse-wheel	Zoom in & out	Zoom in to see more details and zoom out to get a better overview.
Cmd/Ctrl + B	Split	“Split” or “Break” is used to separate a region. This can be used to quickly select areas that later can be removed or moved.
Delete	Delete - selection	"Delete or Clear - selection" is used when editing out audio. In this case a selection of audio.
Cmd/Ctrl + X	Cut - region	"Cut region" is used when editing out audio. In this case an entire region. Use this for removing entire blocks of audio.
Cmd/Ctrl + C	Copy	“Copy” will add the selection to the program memory and can be pasted or inserted later.
Cmd/Ctrl + V	Paste	"Paste" is used when moving audio or placing audio in on top of existing audio.
Cmd/Ctrl + A	Select - regions on track	Select all the regions on one track
Ctrl + G	Group	Group regions together to move the around as a group
Shift + Cmd/Ctrl + right arrow or left arrow	Snap regions	Select a region and use this command to connect it to the next region to the right or left.
